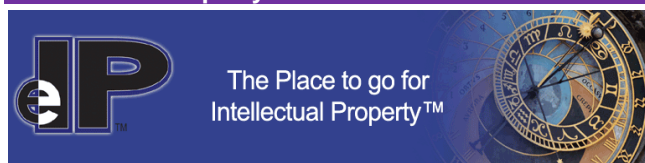

Feedzai, Coimbra technology' company, specialized in the analysis of large volumes of data in real time, has been distinguished as the only EU company, only one of 5 around the world to be a firm Cool Vendor in Business Intelligence.

The Feedzai, located in the Incubator Pedro Nunes, starts in December 2008. Two partner searches from SMEs from the UK – FP7-Health

Both have well-developed technologies that they would like to exploit through topics Health 2012.2.4.3-1 (Innovative approach to manage diabetes), Health 2012.2.4.3-2 (Investigator, driven clinical trials for Type 1 diabetes research), Health2012.2.4.5-2 (Biomarkers, diagnostics for chronic inflammatory diseases of the joints and/or digestive system)

One, Insense is led by Prof Paul Davis who has a long history of successful biotechnology start-ups and has support from the University of Birmingham and the University of Edinburgh.

The other, Mologic, was also formed by Prof Davis. It is seeking a partner that could possibly take on the coordinator role.

Both are registered on the [Fit for Health](#) database as partner searches no 740 and no 741 respectively. Priorities:

- Changes in skin quality during long term diabetes.
- Role of nitric oxide (NO) in maintaining skin quality and controlling regenerative processes.
- Impact of diabetes on NO balance and homeostasis.
- Biomarkers of diabetes progression; Development of topical NO therapeutic.
- Patient management approaches to controlling or reversing diabetes-related pathology.
- Clinical evaluation of therapeutic intervention.

The projects will be concerned with the interaction between nitric oxide (NO), the pathological processes underlying diabetes (Types 1 & 2). It will utilise existing, new biomarkers to characterise the interactions, to relate NO changes to overall disease status. It will investigate one of the most prominent aspects of deterioration, that of damage to skin quality & neurodegeneration as expressed in neuropathic pain, especially in the extremities. In this setting, the potential regenerative effects, pain modulation to be gained by re-balancing the NO system with topically delivered NO will be a major theme. The potential topical therapeutic product will be subjected to clinical evaluation. Biomarker profiles to determine disease status, guide patient management will be investigated/evaluated alongside the NO studies in an integrated clinical programme.

Partner Search from Queen Mary University of London

We use a Bayesian approach to refine GP models and estimate variables for datasets for which infection sources have already been located, enabling us to cross-validate them by their success in identifying the known sources. In parallel we compare the performance of GP models, by quantifying the improvement relative to risk maps generated using traditional methods. We will examine how different modes of disease transmission, vector life history relate to model parameters used in GP, study ways of optimising GP models for different disease classes (human specific; zoonotic; multi-host).

UK led Consortium proposing project under Health 2012.2.3.2-3 Seeks SME Partners

Just registered this one on Fit for Health (no 743). The 3 laboratories currently involved in this project are interested in finding new therapies to treat tuberculosis (TB). At Imperial College London we have been developing bioluminescence imaging of experimental tuberculosis as a tool to accelerate preclinical testing of new therapies. In the Department of Parasitology at the Biomedical Primate Research Centre recent activities have concentrated on converting basic, translational research using primate models into vaccine/drug development for poverty-related diseases. At iThemba Pharmaceuticals, we have been using both phenotypic, target-based approaches to identify/develop new chemical entities for the treatment of TB which responds slowly or is resistant to the existing treatment regimens. Our objective is to validate a novel preclinical non-human primate model using the common marmoset (*Callithrix jacchus*) allowing an integrated evaluation of host pathogenesis/mycobacterial biology under novel drug/combined TB treatment strategies.

1. To validate a new non-human primate model using the common marmoset (*Callithrix jacchus*) to evaluate new therapies to treat TB; these may be new drugs or other immunomodulators. We will implement advanced imaging strategies to provide an integrated view of host pathology and bacterial replication/persistence by using bioluminescent indicator strains of *M.tuberculosis*.
2. To evaluate new drugs, immunomodulators or combination thereof to treat experiment TB in this preclinical model.
3. To investigate the response of mycobacteria to distinctive pathological conditions and/or drug treatments in the NHP model, at transcriptional level, a way of furthering understanding of how mycobacteria develop drug resistance

We envisage the following impacts as outputs of this research programme:

1. A validated novel preclinical/experimental NHP model of tuberculosis using the common marmoset to investigate efficacy of drug therapy with good prospects for clinical translation.
2. An integrated investigation of host pathology in response to mycobacterial replication/persistence using advanced imaging techniques.
3. Preclinical evaluation in NHP of a novel combinatorial approach for immune modulation and/or drug therapies
4. Detailed information in the transcriptional adaptation of *M.tuberculosis* to the dynamic host environment, the therapeutic regimen shall increase our knowledge on the mycobacterial biology in the primate host, allow the possible identification of new drug targets, how mycobacteria develop resistance to drugs.

Coordinated out of Imperial College London, looking for SME partners with the following expertise:

- Anti-mycobacterial drug development with a view to preclinical testing of compounds within the lifetime of the programme.
- Development of immunomodulators for TB treatment, with potential for preclinical testing during the programme.
- Development of methods for imaging bacterial infection *in vivo* such as novel reporters or imaging techniques applicable to small animal models of infection and with potential to accelerate development of new TB drugs.

- Expertise in pharmacokinetics, drug metabolism, an interest in the development of PK models in tuberculosis-NHP infection models.

Top European corporate R&D investors set to increase innovation efforts by 5% a year

Top EU R&D investing companies based expect their global research & development investments to grow by 5% annually from 2011 to 2013. The companies surveyed also revealed that an average of 27% of their annual sales comes from innovative products introduced in the past 3 years, demonstrating again that innovation is the key to commercial success, to job creation. These figures have been published by the EC its 6 EU Survey on R&D Investment Business Trends, a survey of the R&D investment expectations of the 1000 EU companies which invest most in R&D.
